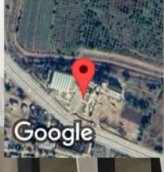
### **Key Learning and Conclusion**

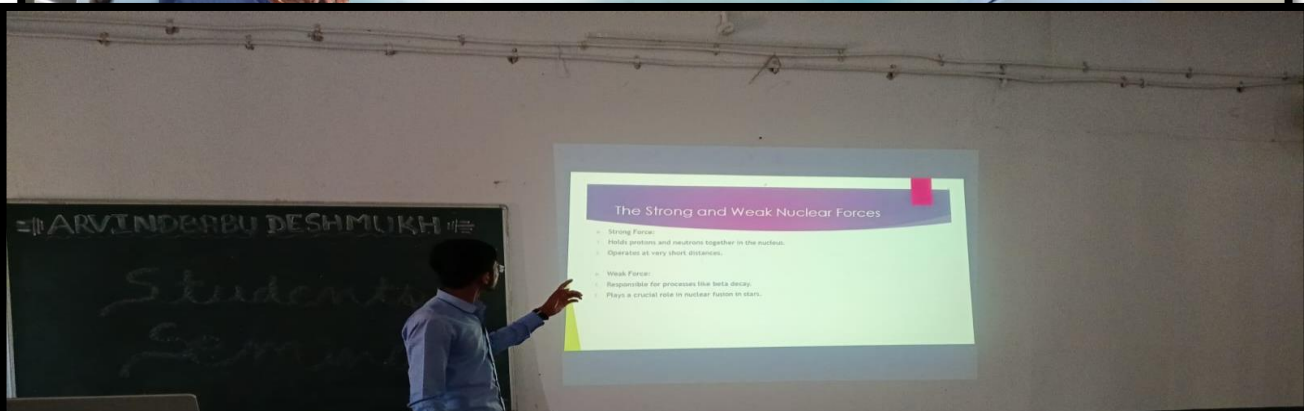
## Group Discussion & Seminar Activity Report

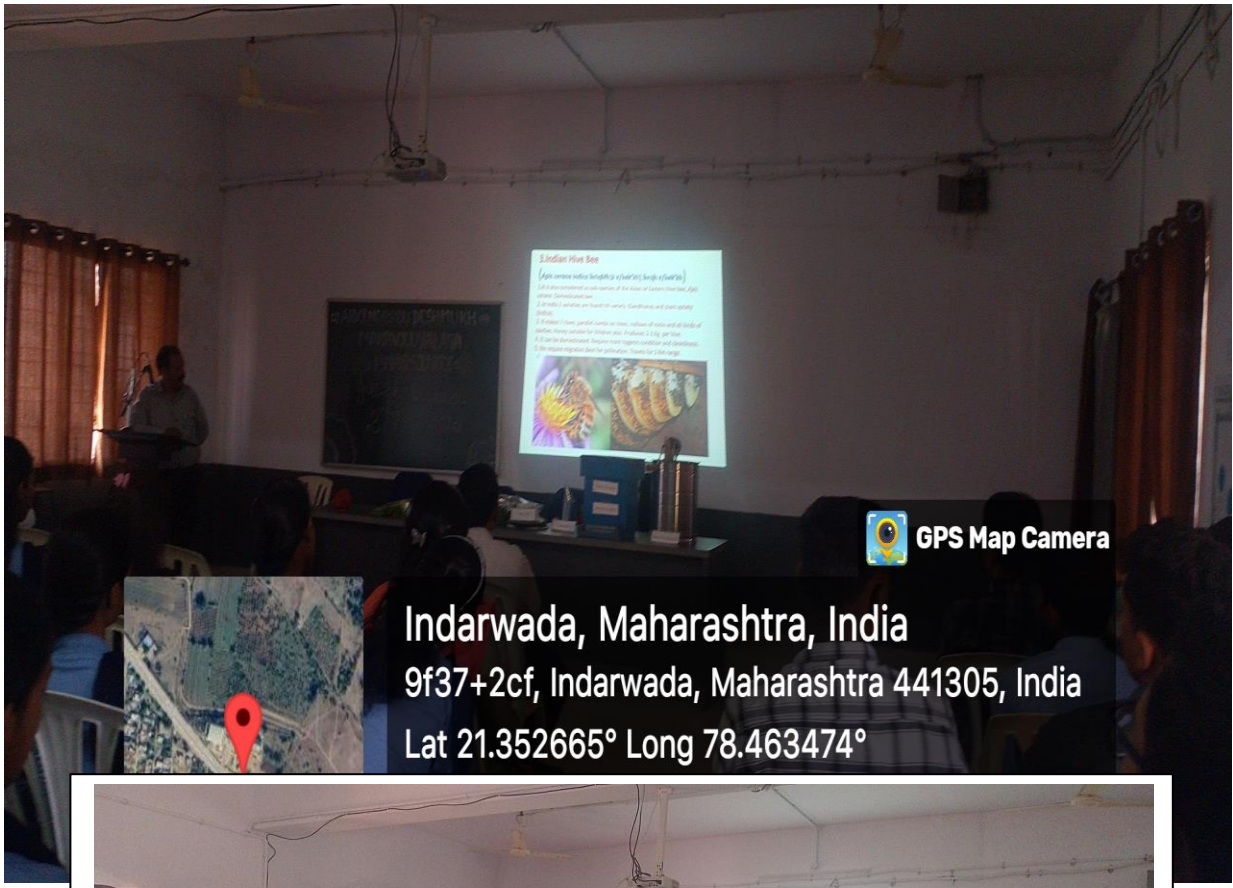
